Marije Elferink-Gemser holds the position of associate professor on the topic 'Sport & Talent' at the Department for Human Movement Sciences, University Medical Center Groningen, University of Groningen, The Netherlands. She has been member of the scientific reviewing panel of the ECSS. In 2005, she was winner of the ECSS YIA oral presentation on her PhD-project on talent development in field hockey. She continued her studies on talented athletes and published over 100 (applied) scientific papers. She has successfully supervised over 15 PhD trajectories on this topic in a variety of sports, among which soccer, basketball, tennis, speed skating, swimming, gymnastics and in PE. Her main interest lies in the field of performance development towards expertise in children and youth. Her studies are characterized by their longitudinal design, focusing on underlying multidimensional performance characteristics of both the youth athletes and their environment. In addition to her research and teaching activities, she gives advice to the Dutch Olympic Committee NOC*NSF, associated sport federations and sport teams, and is trainers/coach of youth speed skaters at Thialf in Heerenveen.
